The large rear bath includes a roomy wardrobe and lavatory sink. And there's no shortage of storage – including a large area beneath the front bed. Options for the 1881 include a convertible sofa/queen bed, and pull-out storage tray.

is an optional sofa/ queen bed – deployed using a space-saving, somersault-flip/rollout action.



In the new Lance 1985, we've taken our very popular "super slideout" dinette and walkaround bed features – and combined them with a full-trailer-width rear bathroom and spacious galley area. There's an abundant amount of storage in this model as well. Options specific to the 1985: convertible sofa/queen bed, and pull-out storage tray.

As in the Lance 1881 and 2281 models, the 1985 has a full-trailer-width rear bathroom – and there's a large exterior storage compartment under the bathroom wardrobe.





Available in the 1881, 1985, 2180 and 2185 models is an optional sofa/queen bed – deployed using a space-saving, somersault-flip/roll-out action.







The new Lance 2185 is a unique lightweight trailer with a rear triple-bunk that can also convert into a large exterior storage garage. Equipped standard to sleep up to seven people in only a 21-foot-long box. A huge U-shaped dinette slideout provides a dance-floor-type feel in the center of the trailer. The forward queen bed has a walk-around on both sides. This 2185 is perfect for the long distance traveler or for family and friends. Options specific to this model: convertible sofa/queen bed, and pull-out storage tray.


## Lance 2185





The Lance 2281, like its sister trailer – the Lance 1881 – is a front walk-around queen bed model with a similar floorplan. But, the 2281 is about four feet longer than the 1881 to accommodate a very comfortable sofa that converts to an additional bed. The large rear bath (seen on pages 6 and 7) includes a roomy wardrobe and lavatory sink. And there's no shortage of storage – including a large area beneath the front bed. Options for the 2281 include a pull-out storage tray.
